**(WE STRONGLY ADVISE THAT YOU READ AND FOLLOW)**

Take care on gravel and all other uneven surfaces and surfaces of all kinds especially when exiting and entering the site, watch for obstacles and hazards.

Observe speed restrictions, traffic signs and all other warning signs at all times. The site speed limit is 5 mph. Speeding on site is a serious offence that puts yourself and others in unnecessary danger. Failing to observe the speed limit, may also result in offenders being escorted from the site for the duration of the event.

Do not obstruct or park on marked access tracks.

Never drive under the influence of drugs or alcohol at any time.

We respectfully remind you that it is mandatory to wear the wristband placed on your wrist when you inscribe for the duration of the event. This must be worn on your wrist only as they are hypoallergenic and should not cause irritations. The security staff will refuse you admission to the Main Hall if you don't, or may even escort you from the site and you may be refused entry to the site on returning. Children's names should be written clearly on their wristbands to aid identification - along with a mobile contact number of the parents or guardians if at all possible to be used as an emergency contact in the unfortunate event that they are lost or hurt. The purchasing of alcohol and underage drinking is not allowed. Children are also not allowed near the working area or near or on site working vehicles. Parents will be held responsible for the actions of their children.

Please pitch your tent within the marked areas and park your bike so that it leans away from and is in no danger of falling on any tents - so leave a safe distance. Remember it is important to use a support plate under the side-stand to spread the load on soft ground.



**(WE STRONGLY ADVISE THAT YOU READ AND FOLLOW)**

Vehicles must park only in the designated areas, as directed. You must be able to park the vehicle on a grassed area. If the vehicle is too heavy it will not be allowed on site. No tents must be pitched or cars parked in the designated motor homes area and access roads to be kept clear at all times. Motor homes and caravans are not to be moved on site once parked up.

In the interest of everyone's health and safety, barbeques must not be left unattended. Do not use naked flames inside tents or gas or any other fuel in poorly ventilated or confined areas. Open fires are strictly prohibited. Take special care when barbequing and cooking with naked flames. An apron may help protect your legs from being burned or scalded but keep it away from the flames.

Familiarise yourself with the location of fire buckets. If you see any are empty please fill them or let the organisers know they need to be filled - remember you may need them quickly!

Be aware that guy ropes pose a tripping hazard so please do not walk between tents unless there is a clear path and even then watch your step.

Only motorcycles, m/c trailers and site admin vehicles are allowed on the main camping field. Cars must be parked in the designated car park area.

If you bring children to this event they are your responsibility. We want them to have as much fun as possible as this is their event too. However, for their safety and well being please ensure all children within your care are supervised and under proper direction at all times both around the site and also in the Main Hall.

First Aid treatment is available at the First Aid Post.

Please be considerate and keep noise to a minimum especially in the evening and be quiet at night when others are trying to sleep, particularly where children and young babies are present. By the same token some people do like to sleep a little later so the same courtesy should be shown early mornings, by early risers.



**(WE STRONGLY ADVISE THAT YOU READ AND FOLLOW)**

Only drinks purchased in the Main Hall Bar may be consumed there - failing to observe this rule may jeopardize the bar license and prevent future events and also remember IT IS THE LAW!!!

Security of belongings. We are operating a 24-hour Security Patrol. Nevertheless, the liability for loss of your belongings rests with you. Please ensure that valuables of all descriptions are never left unattended unless properly locked and secured preferably out of site.

Please use the bin bags provided for rubbish to help keep the site safe and tidy -leaving litter could cause accidents. Bins are located at points around the site and extra bin bags are available from Inscription, All areas of the site are self-clean, so please remove your own rubbish to the bins provided at all times including the Main Hall and Food Area, Remember if you don't clean up your own mess someone else has to, so as a matter of courtesy please try to spread the load! People who volunteer to help have paid the same inscription price as you have.

Before you leave please check your camping area for pegs and debris as the field is also used as a show ground for livestock. Clear away any rubbish to the proper allocated areas.

Please report any defects, safety concerns to the office immediately. Verbal abuse will not be tolerated.

Remember that you have a responsibility to keep yourself and the others in your party safe. Those who do not observe the site safety rules put themselves and others at risk. There is a strong possibility that offenders may be removed from site without refund of admission for the duration of the event.

Any infringement of the rules may result in disciplinary action.
